On September 2, 1989, Bill Lawton and Carol Gillooly were transporting a patient, as a course of their daily duties, with another fellow EMT. A drunk driver in a pickup crossed the center line killing all but one person. To keep Bill and Carol's dream to serve those in need alive, Hunter's Ambulance started a memorial scholarship fund.

This fund is designed to support individuals who are seeking to become Emergency Medical Technicians by providing tuition reimbursement to those who qualify.

To date the classes have trained 400 individuals to become EMT with over 100 of those obtaining scholarships.

Cost of the course is \$485. This covers tuition, AHA CPR cards and disposable medical supplies.

Textbook and workbook are extra. There is an additional cost for State of Connecticut Certification process after course completion.
