A drunk driver in a pickup crossed the center line killing all but one person. To keep Bill and Carol's dream to serve those in need alive, Hunter's Ambulance started a memorial scholarship fund.

Text book costs are not included in the tuition fee. These fees must be paid during the first month of class.

There are additional costs for the State of Connecticut Certification Testing upon course completion.
