HCAP eligibility criteria are as follows:

1. Be a US citizen or permanent resident
2. Live in South Central Connecticut
3. Have a high-school diploma or GED
4. Pass Reading and Math assessments
5. Pass drug screen and criminal background check
6. Receive TANF or fall within income guidelines:
  - Family of 1: \$22,664
  - Family of 2: \$37,145
  - Family of 3: \$50,979
  - Family of 4: \$62,931
  - Family of 5: \$74,271
  - Family of 6: \$86,850
